Anatomy Faculty Position(s)

The Department of Neurobiology and Anatomy at West Virginia University is seeking well-qualified educator(s) at the rank of Assistant, Associate or Full Professor for appointment to a new Education track. This is a three-year, annually renewable appointment (non-tenure). The successful candidate will join departmental colleagues in providing instruction for medical, dental, nursing and other allied health professionals, and in educational innovation and scholarship in the department. Expectations are demonstrated excellence in classroom instruction and a commitment to peer-reviewed scholarship in education. Opportunities are available for qualified applicants to collaborate with departmental labs working in cell biology, cancer research, neuroscience, and cardiovascular and respiratory biology.

Minimum Qualifications: PhD, MD or equivalent degree; record of demonstrated teaching experience (including laboratory instruction) and skills in one or more of the anatomical sub-disciplines: gross anatomy, histology/cell biology, neuroscience, and embryology/developmental anatomy; ability to teach effectively; promise of growth as a health science educator.

Preferred Qualifications: Documentation (grants, peer-reviewed publications and/or teaching materials) of interest and ability in educational scholarship; evidence of experience with a variety of teaching methods; development/design of teaching materials (CAI, course design-, textbooks).

Faculty rank and salary will be commensurate with teaching and research experience. Start-up funds and some shared resources for educational research are available. Search will remain active until the positions are filled; review of applications will begin on May 5, 2008.
